

# RULES OF ETIQUETTE

The safety and health of this community is always our priority. Whether you are strolling through or picking up, we **[always]** want to put you in a **[good]** spot.

The following measures are being implemented to ensure your safety while on property:

- Please abide by all signage and instruction onsite
- Please be polite to others (this includes guests, security and staff)
- Please do not block sidewalks or storefronts (this includes standing or sitting)
- No skating, skateboarding, bicycle riding on sidewalks
- No alcohol or smoking is permitted in public areas
- Please do not climb statues or other objects
- Please keep dog on a leash and clean up after your dog
- No obscene language, shouting, roughhousing and playing music without the use of headphones
- No littering, defacing or destroying property
- No firearms, knives, weapons or drugs permitted on this property
- No tabling, promotions, organized events, gatherings, taking professional photos, videos or recordings without prior written approval from Landlord.
- No loitering
- No soliciting other shoppers or businesses
- Public and Business spaces shall not be used for anything other than their intended purpose

Landlord holds the right to remove or ban any guest in violation of policies. You may be subject to prosecution.

# YOUTH ESCORT POLICY

The safety and health of this community is always our priority. Whether you are strolling through or picking up, we **[always]** want to put you in a **[good]** spot.

The following measures are being implemented to ensure your safety while on property:

As part of the commitment to a preserving a welcoming environment for all guests at Waugh Chapel Towne Centre and The Village at Waugh Chapel, a Youth Escort Policy shall be implemented within the common areas of the shopping center. This area encompasses the outdoor plazas, sidewalks and parking areas and will be effective as of September 1, 2012.

The Youth Escort Policy is an enhancement to Waugh Chapel Towne Centre and The Village at Waugh Chapel existing Safety Program, which features foot and vehicular patrol by Silver Star Security and Anne Arundel County Police Department Uniformed Secondary Employment. "Youth escort" policies, also known as "adult chaperone" or "teen curfew" policies, have successfully been implemented in shopping centers throughout the country to widespread praise from parents and school officials.

- Waugh Chapel Towne Centre and The Village at Waugh Chapel guests under 17 are required to be accompanied by a parent, or guardian 21 years or older while in the common areas after 9 p.m.
- Security will begin monitoring those entering the property at 8 p.m. Unescorted youths within the common areas prior to 9 p.m. must leave the property by 9 p.m. or be joined by a parent, or guardian 21 years or older.
- Guests aged 17 and under may patronize establishments with extended operating hours by proceeding directly to and from the establishment (subject to individual store policies).
- Individuals utilizing public or other forms of transportation must schedule their departure time to ensure compliance with the Youth Escort Policy.
- Any person violating the posted Youth Escort Policy or Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the property.
- Individuals in violation of the Youth Escort Policy or in violation of any posted rules who refuse to leave the property when requested to do so by security officers may be prosecuted for trespassing.
- Proof of age will be required if the age of the youth and/or parent(s) or guardian is not easily determined. Those whose age cannot be determined and who lack identification will be asked to leave the property.
- Anyone appearing to be 17 years or younger should be prepared to show valid identification (with picture and date of birth). Acceptable identification includes a driver's license, state or military identification card, passport or visa.
- Youths under 17 working on property will be allowed access without a parent or guardian. Proof of work status will be required, and youth employees must go directly to the place of employment and must leave the property at the conclusion of their work shift if the shift ends after 9 p.m.
- Parental or guardian escorts must maintain visual contact with all children for whom they are responsible.
- One parent may escort all of his/her children. Additionally, one parent, or guardian 21 years or older, may escort up to three youths. At least one of these youths must be the child of the parent or guardian.
- Parents or guardians are accountable for the actions of youth they escort. If an escorted youth is banned from Waugh Chapel Towne Centre and The Village at Waugh Chapel, the adult escort will also be banned for the same period of time.
- The Youth Escort Policy is posted at all entrances. Security personnel are responsible for enforcing this policy and related procedures.
